- Courses may be adjusted according to the actual progress of students.

- Chess course will be taught in English by World Chess Federation **FIDE Trainer Kiki Chen**.

How to tell your kid's level?

- **Preschoolers Level** - For Preschoolers only. No Prior chess knowledge required.
- **Introduction Level** - This group is for students 5 years old or older. No Prior chess knowledge required. Players will learn: the names of the pieces, how they move, and their numerical value.
- **Entry Level** - This group is for students 5 years old or older with basic knowledge of chess and who know how to move all the pieces. They will learn how to make good decisions about captures and opening principles.
- **Intermediate I** - This group is for our players who are rated 600 to 900. Players will participate in strategy and tactical skill building, and learn opening traps, basic middle game strategy and tactics, bughouse game.
- **Intermediate II** - This group is for players who are rated 900 to 1200. Students will receive coaching on their individual game performance strengths and weaknesses. They will learn advanced King attacks and Checkmating Patterns.
- **Advanced I** - This group is for tournament experienced players who are rated 1200+. Students will receive coaching on tournament advanced strategy, midgame theory, basic rules of endgame and more systematic training.
- **Advanced II** - This group is for tournament experienced players who are rated 1600+. Students will receive coaching on chess openings, tactical positions, basic positional ideas (mainly weak pawns, space, and weak squares), theory and plan from middle game to endgame and the golden rules of the endgame.
